

BY CAR

SAT NAV does not get you to the festival site. Please follow directions and our festival road traffic signage to GREEN GATE for cars and ORANGE GATE for campervans.

It is important to follow the festival road traffic signs as soon as you see them, and nearer to the festival site there are also permanent signs for Larmer Tree Gardens, which are brown with a white flower.

IF YOU WANT TO USE SAT NAV

Sat Nav is not smart enough to deal with the narrow roads around Larmer Tree.

The postcodes we recommend here will get you onto the best roads. The postcode for Larmer Tree Gardens itself will often lead to problems!

From London, Midlands, Wales, The North, Bristol and the South West: enter the postcode SP7 OPP. This is just over 4 miles to the north of Larmer Tree at which point you can turn off the Sat Nav and follow our AA signs.

From the South Coast, Bournemouth and Southampton: enter the postcode DT11 8DD. This is just over 2 miles south of Larmer Tree at which point you can follow our festival road traffic signs.

If you use the southern approach please expect a wait with our stop & go controlled traffic staff in the single lane section by New Town just before the festival site.

OLD FASHIONED DIRECTIONS

From LONDON

Take the M3 and leave at Junction 8 onto the A303.

Travel on the A303 for about 47 miles, and turn south on the A350 to Shaftesbury.

From Shaftesbury take the A30 towards Salisbury.

After about 3 miles (at Ludwell), turn right into Dennis Lane and follow the festival signs.

From BATH & BRISTOL

From the A36, take the A350 to Shaftesbury.

From Shaftesbury take the A30 towards Salisbury.

After about 3 miles (at Ludwell), turn right into Dennis Lane and follow the festival signs.

From the SOUTHWEST

(Directions from Ilchester)

Travel east on the A303. Turn south onto the A350 towards Shaftesbury.

From Shaftesbury take the A30 towards Salisbury.

After about 3 miles (at Ludwell), turn right into Dennis Lane and follow the festival signs.

From the SOUTH

(not recommended due to the Steam Fair taking place between Blandford & our turnoff)

On the A354 leave Blandford Forum heading North East and about 9 miles out of Blandford, look for signs to Larmer Tree Gardens turning left.

Where possible we recommend an approach to Larmer Tree Gardens from the North, coming through Ludwell rather than from the South and East.
